Important Dates

Primary + Primary Runoff

Monday, May 19, 2025 – Deadline to register to vote or update address for the PSC Special Primary Election and Special Election Runoff

Primary

Monday, May 26, 2025 – First day absentee ballots may be mailed to voters for the Special Primary

Monday, May 26, 2025 – **Friday, June 13, 2025** – Advanced in person (early) voting (hours are at least 9am to 5pm but may be longer based on jurisdiction) for the Special Primary

Saturday, May 31, 2025 AND Saturday, June 7, 2025 – Mandatory Saturday voting days (hours are at least 9am to 5pm but may be longer based on jurisdiction) for the Special Primary

Sunday June 1, 2025 AND/OR Sunday, June 8, 2025 – Optional Sunday voting day (not available in all jurisdictions) for the Special Primary

Friday, June 6, 2025 – Deadline to submit an absentee ballot application for the June 17th Special Primary election (but we encourage people to request much sooner to get their ballot in time to vote!)

Tuesday, June 17, 2025– SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY. Polls open at 7:00am and close at 7:00pm. All absentee ballots (other than military/overseas voters) must be RECEIVED by the county registrar by 7:00pm (by mail or in person).

Primary Runoff

As soon as possible – First day absentee ballots may be mailed to voters for the Special Primary Runoff

As soon as possible, but no later than July 7, 2025 - July 11, 2025 - Advanced in person (early) voting (hours are at least 9am to 5pm but may be longer based on jurisdiction) for the Special Primary Runoff

Tuesday, June 17, 2025– SPECIAL PRIMARY RUNOFF ELECTION DAY. Polls open at 7:00am and close at 7:00pm. All absentee ballots (other than military/overseas voters) must be RECEIVED by the county registrar by 7:00pm (by mail or in person).

Vote by Mail

Planning to vote by mail for the June 17th special primary election and the July 15th Runoff? Don't wait to submit your applications! You must submit a request for each election Get your applications here: https://securemyabsenteeballot.sos.ga.gov/s/

• Use between: April 30 - May 28

Are you voting by mail for the June 17th Public Service Commission primary election? If you received your ballot, fill it out and return it ASAP!

• Use Between: May 27 - June 10

Have a vote by mail ballot? Your elections office must receive your ballot by 7pm on June 17th. Drop it off at your elections office, or mail it back ASAP!

• Use between: June 2 - June 9

Do you still have to return your completed vote by mail ballot? Drop it off at your county's elections office or at a drop box – or go vote early in person!

Use between: June 10 - June 13 and July 7 - June 11

Do you still plan to return your vote by mail ballot? You MUST drop it off at your elections office by 7pm TODAY. Or go vote in person! Polls are open 7am to 7pm.

• Use on: June 17 and July 15

Planning to vote by mail for the July 15th special primary RUNOFF election? Don't wait to submit your application! Get your application here: https://securemyabsenteeballot.sos.ga.gov/s/

• Use between: June 18 - July 1

Are you voting by mail for the July 15th Public Service Commission primary RUNOFF election? If you received your ballot, fill it out and return it ASAP!

• Use Between: June 23 - July 7
